About this agreement:

Lackawanna College and Marywood University have agreed to a correlation of their curricula for students in the Associate in Science: Human Services program at Lackawanna College who wish to complete the Bachelor of Social Work at Marywood University. Subject to the terms of this agreement, a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of the AS degree at Lackawanna College with a 2.5 grade point average or above, will be granted admission to Marywood University and will have his/her credits earned with a grade of 'C' or better, accepted for transfer based on the articulation agreement equivalency. However, the following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) A minimum of 121 credits are required for an undergraduate degree in Social Work at Marywood University.
- 2) Transfer students following this articulation must **complete a minimum of 30 credits at Marywood.**
- 3) Students must maintain a 2.33 GPA in their major, and a 2.0 overall GPA in order to graduate from Marywood.
- 4) This agreement is to be used as a guide only. **Marywood University cannot guarantee that the needed courses will be offered in a given semester.**
- 5) The University estimates that a student can earn her/his BSW in two years (minimum of four semesters) provided s/he follows the articulation agreement, and utilizes dual enrollment in the last year of attendance at Lackawanna College.
- 6) The student must meet all deadline dates for application to the University, payment of fees, and any other deadlines as they apply to all new students at Marywood.
- 7) The student shall choose the recommended elective courses and course sequences as shown on the articulation agreement.
- 8) The student must not attend another institution of higher education between graduating from Lackawanna College and enrolling at Marywood University.

Notice regarding dual enrollment:

Students who transfer from Lackawanna College utilizing the Dual Enrollment Articulation agreement are able to complete the MSW Program (full-time) three years after matriculation at Marywood. While in the BSW Program at Marywood, students earning a 'B' or better in all Social Work courses are able to earn up to 21 credits toward the Marywood MSW degree. **Important:** all dual enrollment credits must be completed before students graduate from Lackawanna.

If any of the above terms and conditions are not met, Marywood University shall determine the appropriate number of transfer credits on an individual basis.

Students who wish to transfer to Marywood University prior to obtaining their Associate's degree from Lackawanna College must submit their official transcript for a course-by-course evaluation.

This agreement may be terminated at any time by either Marywood University or Lackawanna College via a written notice thirty days in advance of the effective date of termination. It is understood that any termination will not apply to students who have already started the Associate Degree program in Human Services or the BSW program at Marywood University.
