

Find Media Items



Search [Our Catalog](#), the library online catalog, to find media items for their call numbers. The best way to search is to do a **Power Search** on our online catalog.

- Select a *search index* (such as Title or Subject) in the drop-down list and enter the subject or key word, etc.
- Select the *type* (such as Audio-visual).
- Click on the *Search* button to look for a videotape or a CD.

Music discs: Located on the main/second floor of the library.

Videotapes/ DVDs: Most are shelved in the stacks with books.
