Where to find newspapers in the Library

Recent newspapers are housed in the library's Newspaper Reading Room located on the first floor. All recent newspapers are kept in print form for approximately 2 months.

In addition to those received in print only, the library keeps back issues on microfilm for:



- *Catholic Light*
- *New York Times*
- *Times Educational and Literary Supplements*
- *Wall Street Journal*
- *National Catholic Reporter*
- *Times-Tribune*
