Meetings

The members of the Undergraduate Admissions Committee met throughout the fall and spring semesters in monthly meetings.

Accomplishments

Actions taken this year included:

1. Making 1,120 offers of acceptance to the University as of the date of publication of this report. These acceptances included prospective freshmen, transfers to Undergraduate programs, and students who had previously attended Marywood and have chosen to return and complete their studies.
2. Offering enrollment to 62 students with special conditions - a reduction of 15 from the previous cycle as of the date of publication of this report.
3. Offering enrollment to 32 students through the ACT 101 program.

Additionally the committee began discussions concerning the changes to the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT I) scheduled to begin with the March 2005 examination for students planning to enter college in the fall of 2006. The goal of these discussions will be to create recommendations concerning implementation of the new scores and evaluating their potential impact on future admissions decisions.
