All post-bachelors admission students receive scholarship aid during their first four years of the program, post-Master's admission students receive two years of scholarship aid. The basic scholarship amount for 2016-2017 is \$3,800 in the form of a tuition waiver. Students in their third year of training are eligible to apply for one of four half-time Graduate Assistantships which include partial tuition remission (12.75 credits) and a stipend (\$2,720 for the academic year). Once students complete their Master's degree they are eligible to apply for available part-time teaching positions in our undergraduate psychology program (salary for teaching a three credit course is \$2,205).
