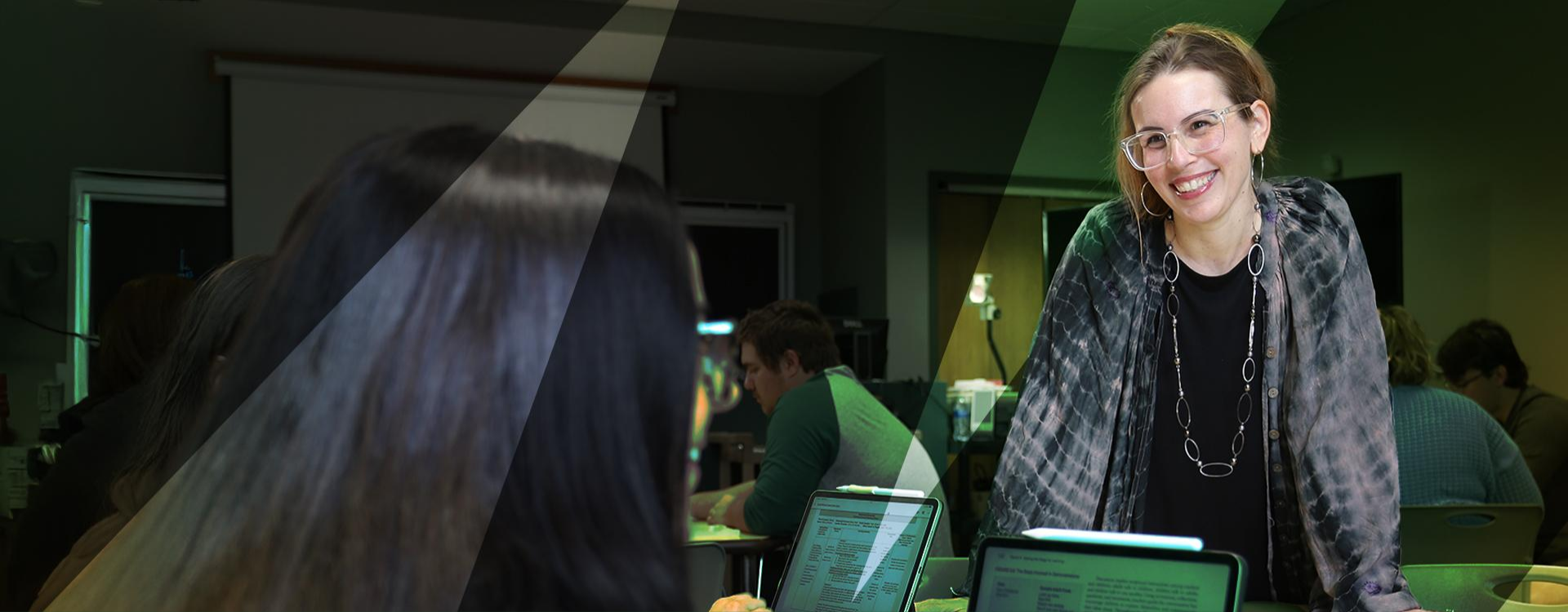

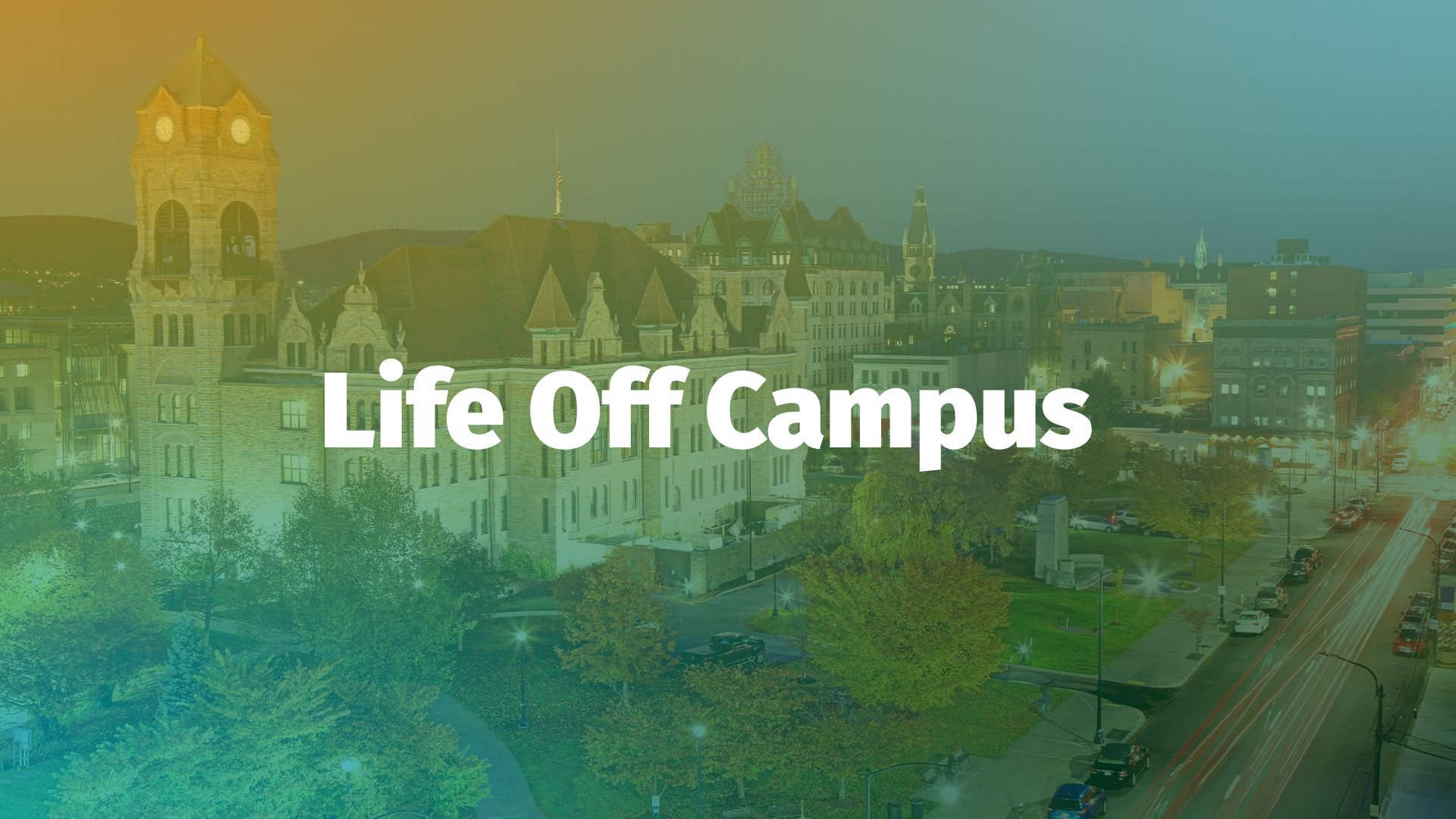

Ready to Apply?

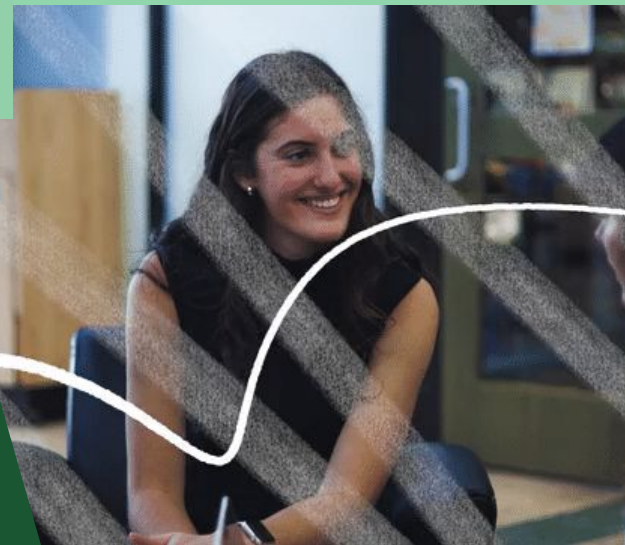
- Apply using the Common App or Marywood App
(free if you apply online!) →
- Decision within 7-10 business days
once we receive all required documents.

Items to Submit

- Completed Application
- Official High School Transcript
- 1 Letter of Recommendation
- Official SAT/ACT Scores (Optional)

Transferring to Marywood?

- Transfer students are evaluated on their most recent full-time college experience
- Transfer students for Architecture, Education, Nursing & Pre-PA must have a minimum 3.00 GPA
- Transfer students interested in CSD must have a minimum 3.50 GPA



Coming in with College Credits?

- AP Credits: 3 or higher on test
- IB Credits: 5 or higher on test
- Dual Enrollment: C or higher
