ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- Within the College of Health Sciences
- Accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care
- 2 full time faculty (PD, DCE); 6 adjunct faculty
- Students will graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy and be eligible to sit for the TMC exam



Admission Requirements

- If you did not take the SATs and are a transfer student a minimum GPA of 2.5 is required
- If you do not meet any of these requirements, you can come in as “Interest in Respiratory Therapy” and work towards obtaining a GPA of 2.5 - after which you will be admitted in to the major
- Students who are in the category of “Interest in Respiratory Therapy” are still assigned a respiratory therapy advisor and take most of the same classes as students in the major, but are NOT eligible to take any Respiratory Therapy courses



Program Requirements

- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Achieve a C or better in all science courses with their respective labs
- Achieve a C or better in all Respiratory Therapy courses
- C or better in statistics
- Successfully complete all Respiratory Therapy clinicals
- Complete 5 hours of service learning each semester you are enrolled in a Respiratory Therapy course
- Pass the SAE with a minimum score of 86



The Curriculum

- First year: science courses and other core requirements
- Sophomore year: RESP 100, RESP 110, and RESP 300/300L/300C; finish up core requirements
- Junior year: RESP 310/310L/310C, RESP 320, RESP 330, RESP 340/340L/340C, RESP 325, and RESP 350
- Senior year: RESP 420/420L/420C, RESP 410, RESP 430/430L/430C, and RESP 445
