The 2025 Annual Report for the Bachelor of Architecture program at Marywood University was reviewed during the April 17-18, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB).

Based on the review of the Annual Report, the NAAB directors voted to accept the Annual Report and require a Special Report to address the following areas:

Condition 6.1 Statement on NAAB-Accredited Degrees

The program must provide evidence that the exact language found in the 2020 NAAB Conditions for Accreditation, Appendix 2, is provided in catalogs and promotional media, including the program's website. At the time of review, the Statement on the program's website was out of date.

Condition 6.3 Access to Career Development Information

The program must demonstrate that students and graduates have access to architecture-specific career development and placement services that help them develop, evaluate, and implement career, education, and employment plans. This information must be posted online and easily available to the public.

Condition 6.5 Admissions and Advising

The program must provide evidence that admissions-decisions procedures, including policies and processes for evaluation of transcripts and portfolios (when required); and decisions regarding remediation and advanced standing are posted online and easily available to the public.

The program must provide a narrative and supporting evidence to demonstrate compliance with the Condition(s) noted. The Special Report is due no later than June 30, 2026.
