

APPLICATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

- 1. Carefully complete the Application for Admission to Marywood University, signing and dating the application.
- 2. Attach a \$35 check or money order, payable to Marywood University, to your application. Please do not send cash through the mail. The application fee is non-refundable.
- 3. Request that the appropriate agency send your SAT-1 or ACT scores directly to the Office of University Admissions, Marywood University, 2300 Adams Avenue, Scranton, PA 18509. Marywood will accept scores reported on official transcripts. Marywood's code number for the College Board (SAT-1) is 2407 and for ACT is 3626.
- 4. Request an official copy of your high school transcript be sent to the Office of University Admissions, Marywood University, 2300 Adams Avenue, Scranton, PA 18509.
- 5. If you are applying for admission as a transfer student, please have official transcripts sent from all educational institutions (high schools, colleges, etc.) in which you have or are enrolled to the Office of University Admissions, Marywood University, 2300 Adams Avenue, Scranton, PA 18509.
- 6. If you are an international student and your primary language is not English, please have an official report of your scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or IELTS sent to the Office of University Admissions, Marywood University, 2300 Adams Avenue, Scranton, PA 18509. USA. Marywood's code number for TOEFL is 2407.
- 7. Provide at least one letter of recommendation from someone (counselor, instructor, other) who is familiar with your academic background. We also welcome additional letters from teachers or friends who are also familiar with your academic achievements and interests.
- 8. Include a Personal Statement (attach a separate sheet) explaining why you have chosen your area of study (or why you have not decided on a major).
